

FAQ – Erasmus trainees at HHU

1. How long does a traineeship last?

Max. three months, although a mandatory traineeship may be longer.

2. What do I need to bear in mind when defining the traineeship period?

Like all students, you pay a "semester fee" of currently €310 per semester that allows you to use the halls of residence/canteens and includes a travel pass (see point 6). So your traineeship should not be longer than one semester as you will otherwise have to pay the semester fee twice. April 1 to September 30 = summer semester, October 1 to March 31 = winter semester.

3. How do I find an advisor?

Please approach the subjects or institutes where you would like to complete a traineeship. If you are seeking an Erasmus traineeship in medicine, please contact the clinical departments. You can find detailed information here.

4. What documents do I need?

You need to provide your home university with (among other things) a signed Grant Agreement (= agreement between the student and home university) and a signed Learning Agreement/Student Mobility for Traineeships (= agreement between the home university and advisor). You are responsible for coordinating the agreements with those involved and ensuring they are signed.

5. Will I receive a student ID card for HHU?

Yes. Your HHU card (= student ID card) will be sent to you by post.

6. Will I receive a travel pass?

Yes. The HHU card is also a travel pass for the public transport system in North Rhine-Westphalia (NRW). You can travel on all buses, trams, subways and regional trains in NRW throughout the semester.

7. Am I insured in the event of an accident?

Yes, because you are enrolled at the university. You are insured for any accidents on the university campus or during direct journeys to HHU.

9. Will the International Office support me in applying for a visa?

Not as a general rule, but there is one exception: If you are a non-EU citizen with a valid visa for another EU country, the International Office (Monika Lent-Öztürk) will apply for your visa.
